You may visit our website without providing any personal data. The website uses cookies to collect data on traffic in the website

Our purpose herein is to enable you an easier visit to our website and to understand how to improve the website functions.

A cookie is a small file containing a set of characters that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. Cookies aim to enable a more user-friendly experience of a website.

Cookies enable the presentation of personalized web pages for a more customized and swifter user-experience. Cookies cannot collect any information stored in your computer or your files, including your personal data.

### What is a cookie?

A cookie is small sized text file that the website you visit saves to your computer or your mobile device. Cookies are used extensively to enable a more efficient functioning of a website or to provide data for the host website.

#### How do we utilize cookies?

The cookies loaded onto your computer or the data obtained through them are used for statistical analyses and security measures. No personal data is collected through cookies.

## How can you control cookies?

You can control and delete cookies as you wish. You can delete existing cookies in your computer and block them from being saved/loaded through most internet browsers.

## How can you manage internet browser cookies?

Most internet browsers enable to carry out the following actions:

- To view all stored cookies and delete any ones you wish
- Block third party cookies
- Block cookies from specified websites
- Block all cookies
- Delete all cookies when you turn browser off

In case you prefer to delete the cookies, your preferences in the website in question will be deleted.

Also, if you prefer to block cookies many websites including the Call to Friendship website may not function fully and properly.
